Wren and Harold McGee. Others underwent the suffering of prisoners of war. Others were wounded by enemy fire. It was a turbulent and memorable time!

Betty Started It

Without Betty Jacobs it is probable — no, certain — that the 1943 graduating class would not have developed the special relationship which it has. (Early on, she married Curt and added "Aufranc" to her name.)



A dictionary definition of "reunion" is: "a gathering of the members of a group who have been separated."

Betty not only conceived the idea of reuniting the members of the graduating class of 1943, but she made sure it happened. She organized the first reunion in 1957 and was the guiding force behind the 11 reunions which followed. Of course, she had a lot of assistance from other local classmates who pitched in with ideas and with help.



Even after her death in 2006, her spirit permeated the gathering. She was remembered and honored by her classmates in the establishment of the Betty Jacobs Aufranc Special Needs Fund to aid special Hickman High students.

greetings to everyone and says she is still fairly O.K., adding that she walks a bit every day, "but not as far as before."



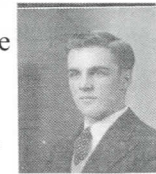
Her daughter lives nearby and comes by regularly. Also, there is a nurse across the street who checks to see if her window shades go up by 9:30 each morning.
